Great Western 10k –

Free entry information - slightly confusing. (Original draft will be re written, idea is to enter & reclaim. Must be clear to enter, pay & then re claim.)

YTRRC to concentrate on the race, we use Somerset for all licences & not Dorset. Details of farmer's & any residences that have received letters we require copies of the letters etc. Licensed under Dorset for this race and all information required in case we are scrutinised.

Householder sheet for everyone along the route to go through doors – Russ to organise, 3 packs given out by Russ to the Committee.

Marshall Points, water stations decided by MC & Ines Braun from Gillingham Trotters, need to check and complete Risk assessment. Need to do a recce run and complete the run 2 weeks before hand at same time of day etc. Course start & finish to be checked after feedback from previous race.

(There may be a possibility of moving the race to a Sunday in the next few years)

40 – 60 marshal's available from the Rotary to help. Fri set up course, Sat run & remove. Tents for changing, first aid, toilets & marquee to be removed on Sun (tables, chairs, car park notices etc all available) More runners from club? Rotary given Advertisements to the National Running press – Tri main area.

Entries so far - 4

All clubs in South West emailed over Christmas with Race Information.

Rotary has umbrella Insurance that covers for up to 2500 people.

Car parking for 400 – 500, Plus extra field but if weather bad not usable.

Race is 50/50 road/off road. Farmer not decided on crops yet and this will decide course through his field.
