Treasurer's Report

Points raised from the auditing of the Accounts:

Storage Facilities:

Spread around about 4 Members at present but needs to be stored together centrally.

Option 1: Running Track, garage available but we will need to pay for repairs to roof and ongoing upkeep & repairs. Costs given by the Council but not preferred choice due to costs and unexpected hidden costs that may be incurred.

Option 2: Metal Storage Container, possibility of keeping at Football Ground. Vandal proof and available locally they can have a build up of condensation but will line ours if we go down this route. Approx cost £800 plus delivery charge - await response from Football Club.

Race Clock:

MC looking for a volunteer in late summer to look after and move the clock around the various clubs, due to lack of back seat space being available. Clock owned by 4 clubs and quite cumbersome to transport. Phil to look at possibility of buying more big bags for storage & protection of the clock.
