- 300 Marathon & 500 Half marathon "T" shirts had been ordered and paid for
- An outside organization had been contracted to provide 1st Aid cover
- Entries had now closed which in view of the low numbers the committee wondered if entries on the day might have been an option
- At this point Income was £16000+ & outgoings some £13000 with some additional outgoings still to be paid
- There was lengthy discussions on the liaison between the race director and the committee.
- The late ordering of the T Shirts which incurred large excess payments
- Shortage of Marshals
- Control of runners on multiple loops of the course
- The committee resolved to investigate all of these problems at a later date but to fully support this years event
