Chairman's report – Steve Warren

• Track is back up and running as are Tuesday club runs. At track, the council has confirmed they are happy for the club to have 3 groups of 12 training. Running a third group was discussed and it was agreed that from Friday there would be 3 groups running. Each group would be separate and there would be no mixing between the groups. These groups can be different each week. Individuals will be able to book on a weekly basis and will be able to book for up to 4 weeks in advance. Members will need to cancel if they are unable to attend a session.

Treasurer's report – Simon Rowbottom

- At the previous committee meeting the question was asked where does club membership fees go? SR provided a breakdown of costs which will be made available on the club website. SR also confirmed that track costs approx. £2k per year and profits from events goes towards this. The club has also paid for hats, transport and meals etc. The current bank account is at £5,500. SR advised the committee needed to consider whether to ask members who are using the track to make a contribution to cover the £30 per week that it would cost to use the track or about £800. SW advised that it would be prudent not to let the bank balance drop below £4k due to initial outlay costs of setting up events. The club already has medals for next years Easter Bunny. The club still has money to pay to the Jane Tomlinson appeal. Donations are only made to Yeovilton if we hold races there. At the moment, until Yeovilton give the club the all clear to hold events there it is difficult to plan any events/races from there.
- AH suggested whether in August the club could do a race in Ninesprings, this would then be all off road.
- SW asked whether the costs for the website was a yearly cost, SR confirmed that this
 was a yearly cost.
- It was agreed that a breakdown of the running costs of the club would be put on the
 website so that members can see where their membership fees go and see the costs of
 running the club.
- It was agreed to review the costs of the track after 3 months to determine whether the club would need to ask members to make a donation for future use of the track.

- SR said that he had looked at the possibility of getting a grant, SW and SR will look into
 this and whether we as a club would be eligible for this. Applications have to be in by the
 end of May.
- SW still has £70 in petty cash and would speak to Kevin to see if he needed any money towards ink.
- SW has also spoken to Yeovil Hospital Charity and will be arranging a cheque presentation

Membership report - Adam Hawkins

- There are a couple of people who have moved out of the area but a lot of members have still to renew. AH has also received paperwork from ARC in relation to our ARC membership.
- We currently have 133 members, 4 are new to the club and 4 are second claim members. There is now a new EA portal which AH has been using to register members.
- AH asked if we had a list of people who are coaches? SW has contacted EA to reapply
 for his LIRF course, AH would like to know who are coaches so that they can be
 registered as coach. At present, Nathan is the only person who is a qualified coach. PM
 will have a look to see if he has a list and will then send this to AH.

- Wessex Ridgeway will be going ahead on July 10th. After some discussion it was agreed that the club would not enter this event this year due to Covid restrictions
